### **EXTERMINATOR**

Beginning in the first week in November, we will be treating ALL Apartments on a Preventative Schedule. The exterminator will be scheduling treatment by Floor. We will be starting on the 17th Floor November 5, 2021, and moving down a floor each week. If you have pest concerns, please continue to report them to the Front Desk NO LATER than Thursday at noon so that you can be added to the list.

### **COMPUTERS**

Please do not change any settings for the computers in the Library or the 18th Floor. Residents are changing the WiFi settings or program settings and causing issues with the computers. Please remember that these are SHARED computers. You should Log out of your email and any open pages when you are finished using them.

### **OVERNIGHT GUESTS**

Please remember that the Resident has to come to the front Desk and pick up the overnight Passes. If your guest is staying past midnight, they should have an overnight pass.

### TRASH ROOM AND CHUTES

As stated in the Rules and Regulations, trash is not to be put down the trash chute after 10 pm daily. Please be considerate of your neighbors and wait until the next day to take your trash to the trash room. Please do not leave the trash in the trash room. It is not management's responsibility to clean up after residents that continue to leave trash, cat litter, and other items in the trash room. Please refrain from doing this in the future to avoid a violation letter from management.

### LAUNDRY ROOM CARTS



### MESSAGE FROM SOCIAL SECURITY Cost-of-Living Adjustment for 2022

Social Security & Supplemental Security Income (SSI) benefits for nearly 69 million Americans will increase 5.9 percent in 2022. This is the biggest hike in roughly 40 years.

The 5.9 percent cost-of-living adjustment (COLA) will begin with benefits in January 2022. Increased payments to more than 8 million SSI beneficiaries will begin on 12/31/2021. (Note: some people receive both Social Security and SSI benefits).

### **MEDICARE SUBSCRIBERS**

Open enrollment for Medicare Coverage ends December 7th. This is the time you can switch to a Medicare Advantage Plan -Medicare Plan C or D, return to straight Medicare, or just Enroll. The Effective date is January 1, 2022. It is wise to check if there are plans in this area that offers better health and/or drug coverage at a more affordable price. Most pharmacies in the area have this high-dose flu vaccine but be sure to call ahead in case they require an appointment. Covid booster shots are also available by appointment at local pharmacies & local hospitals. It is highly recommended that you receive both vaccines.

The flu vaccine may reduce the severity of the illness and is a very important preventive tool for people with certain chronic health conditions including; cardiac, diabetes and chronic lung disease. We will NOT Be offering these shots in the Building.
