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

LAUNDRY ROOM & CARTS

The Laundry Room is for resident use ONLY. Family members are not permitted to use the laundry room for personal use. Laundry Carts are not to be removed from the Laundry Room. If you use the carts, please put them back under the shelf. Please do not leave trash on the floor, and make sure to the dryer is cleaned out for the next person to use. Please do not forget to remove the lint after your use the stackable dryers.

PACKAGES & PERSONAL ITEMS

Please remember that we can not hold packages or personal items at the front desk. Please remind your family that you must be home if they will be dropping anything off for you.

If you are processing a return, your package MUST be labeled and sealed before leaving at the front desk. The Front Desk is not responsible for sealing packages or applying mailing labels from vendors.





Rent Processing Errors
