Please remember to stay cool and be safe in the summer heat. The heat index is sweltering and has been in the triple digits. Please stay inside unless necessary and stay safe.

FRONT ENTRANCE GARDEN AREA

EMPLOYEE APARTMENT DOORS

Please do not knock on employees doors for work orders or lost keys. ALL work orders need to be submitted to the Front Desk. If you borrow your apartment key from the front desk and did not return it– you need to call the Front Desk. The Front Desk will notify whomever is on call

GOING AWAY FOR A FEW DAYS??

If you are going away overnight or for a few days? Please remember to let the Front Desk know. We continue to do daily wellness checks and will enter your apartment to check on you, unless you tell the Front Desk you are going away.

WELCOME MATS AND RUGS

Please remember that welcome mats and rugs are not allowed to be in the hallway at your apartment doors. Any rugs or welcome mats need to be on the inside of your door. These can be trip hazards, please be careful if you have a mat or rug at your door. If we find a mat or rug in the hallways, they will be removed. Please do remove any cardboard or other material from the outside bottom of your door.

PACKAGE PICK UP

If someone else is picking up a package for you, you must provide the front desk with a notice in writing giving them permission release your package. We will not be able to take a phone call to verify your permission. Please also remember that large packages need to be picked up right away. Packages not picked up within 3 days will be returned to sender.

We are getting deeper into summer weather. Remember that your thermostat should remain on Auto.

We have a major inspection coming up in December and will be sending out in notices to inspect ALL apartments in September.

Please be mindful when moving through the hallways on your scooters. Walls are being damaged by scooters that are being driven too fast.

Please remember to ALWAYS extinguish candles and incense BEFORE leaving your apartment or going to sleep.

Please report all maintenance concerns as soon as possible. Work orders go to the FRONT DESK— do not stop team members in the hallway to report a work order.

Please do not forget to use your kitchen exhaust fan when you cook. This helps combat the excessive smoke detector noise.

Emergency Contact Update?



EMERGENCY CONTACTS

It is very important that your Emergency Contact Information stays up to date. Have you changed who you would like us to contact? Did a phone number change?

Please remember to update the Compliance Office in the event of any change to your Emergency Contact Information. This includes if you would like to change who can access your apartment in the event that you are incapacitated. The Compliance Office will update the Front Desk and Resident Services.

Resident Services also has forms available to keep in your apartment that list pertinent information for your family in the event of an emergency; such as: doctors, power of attorney, bank, insurance and other contacts.
